# **European Youth Championships**

Ankush Khandelwal and Amisha Parmar are representing England in the Boys Under 16 and Girls Under 14 tournaments, respectively, at the European Youth Championships in Herceg Novi, Montenegro, from 9–20 September. With five of the nine rounds completed, Ankush has 2 points and Amisha 3½.

### **Expansion**

The NCA has been working behind the scenes since the AGM to try to expand chess in Nottinghamshire. The first efforts involve helping to try to set up clubs at Nottingham Trent University and Castle College. David Levens and Ian Kingston attended the Castle College Freshers Fayre and drummed up enough interest to make a club there a serious possibility, and work will continue with both institutions to try to make this a reality. If we succeed, new teams could appear in Division 5 before Christmas.

Places like Castle College, which have many local students, could become a source of players for existing clubs as students leave education and look for clubs elsewhere in the county. And more variety – new faces, new venues – must be a good thing.

#### **Ashfield Championship**

Neil Graham reports that the Ashfield Club Championship was won by Glenn Halfpenny with a perfect 5/5. Richard Webster, Neil Graham, Phil Morgan and Bob Taylor shared second place with 3/5. Ten players competed.

#### **World Championship Match**

The match to reunify the World Championship takes place in Elista, Kalmykia, from 20 September–13 October. FIDE World Champion Veselin Topalov and Classical World Champion Vladimir Kramnik will play a 12 game match to repair the split caused in 1993 when Kasparov and Short broke away from FIDE to play their match.

There is more information at http://www.fide.com/news. asp?id=978, but as yet there is no official web site. In fact, FIDE is doing an appalling job of publicising the match. The days when a World Championship match would allow chess to break out of the confines of the weekly or daily newspaper column and into the news pages seem to be long gone, and FIDE appears to be doing nothing to change this. However, the clash between Topalov's dynamic style and Kramnik's solid positional game could see a genuinely exciting match.

#### League results

The league season started this week, and I'm delighted to say that all results were reported promptly.

Results will be reported here in the same way as last year, except that I will flag provisional results with an asterisk, as on the web site. *Provisional* means one of the following:

I

- The result has been reported, but not in the officially approved manner (match card send via post; scanned copy of match card sent via email). Don't let that stop you emailing typed results to me though.
- The Records Secretary (that's me too) has not been supplied with the relevant details about players new to a club as required under Rule C6.
- The eligibility of a player to play for a particular team (Rule C4) potentially depends on the participants in another match that has yet to be reported.
- I have a life (sort of) and I haven't yet got round to making the necessary checks, even though all the information has been supplied.

Clubs with multiple teams always have to keep an eye on who is eligible to play for which team, so as to avoid incurring a penalty. I will contact any club that appears to have incurred such a penalty to explain why and to give an opportunity for you to correct any error that I might make.

I mentioned at the AGM that combining the roles of Records Secretary and Bulletin Editor/Webmaster would lead to a loss of cross-checking of results, since only one person is now looking at the match cards instead of two. Please, therefore, check your results carefully when they are published and let me know immediately when the inevitable mistakes occur.

The league tables, in both *Notts News* and on the web site, will continue to show the 'two up, two down' promotion and relegation zones, since these are nominally what we are all playing for. Remember that because of the fluctuating number of teams in the league there is no guarantee that teams will be promoted or relegated.
