How to get there



Eligibility

Entry is restricted to players meeting at least one of the following criteria:

- I Born in Nottinghamshire
- 2 Living in Nottinghamshire
- 3 Working in Nottinghamshire
- 4 Attending an educational establishment in Nottinghamshire
- 5 Member of a club based in Nottinghamshire

Notes for competitors

- **Age**: Ages are all taken at 1 September 2008. Juniors are those aged 17 or under on that date; Seniors are those aged 60 or over.
- **Arbiter's decision**: The Arbiter's decision will be final on all matters regarding the tournament.
- **Byes**: Half-point byes may be requested from, and are at the discretion of, the Arbiter for Rounds I–4. Byes are not permitted for Round 5. Only one half-point bye will be permitted for each player.
- **Defaults**: Players not arriving within 30 minutes of the clocks being started for each round will be defaulted. Their opponents will be re-paired if possible.
- **Donations**: All donations towards the cost of staging the championship are welcome.
- **Grading**: Ungraded players must provide full information regarding their playing ability and any grading previously held. Failure to do this may render a player ineligible for a prize.
- **Mobile phones etc.**: All mobile phones and other electronic communication devices must be turned off in the tournament hall. This applies to players and spectators. If a player's phone rings during play, two minutes will be added to the opponent's clock on the first occurrence; for a second offence the player will lose the game.

Parking: The venue has limited parking space.

- **Prizes**: In the event of a tie for any prize the money will be shared. No player may win more than one prize except for the Game of the Day prizes. The Game of the Day prizes will be awarded to the winners of games that entertain, impress or otherwise take the fancy of the organisers. They are not 'Best Game' or 'Brilliancy' prizes. If the game is a draw then the players share the prize. The Senior prize goes to the highest score by a player aged 60 or over, regardless of which section the player is in.
- **Refreshments**: Snacks and beverages will be available throughout the tournament. There are also nearby places to eat.

Scoresheet: The official scoresheets provided must be used to record all games.

- **Smoking**: Smoking is not permitted by players, officials or spectators within the building.
- **Trophies**: The winner of each event will hold the trophy for 12 months or until the competition is next held. Ties will be broken by using the following successively: Sum of Progressive Scores; Sum of Opponents' Scores. If any changes to the tie break criteria are necessary they will be announced during the tournament.
- **Withdrawals**: Players withdrawing without adequate reason or without notifying the organisers may be refused entry to the next championship. Players who withdraw will not be eligible for any prize.
