
TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

From the M1. Exit the M1 at Junction 26, follow the A610 for around 4 miles towards Nottingham, going over a railway bridge afer around 3 miles, continue over the traffic lights at Gregory Boulevardand, and the next set of traffic lights, turn left at traffic lights onto Forest Road West, with the Dixey Chicken on the corner. Continue along Forest Road West, go



straight over the traffic lights into Forest Road East, and then turn right in around 100 metres into the school car park.

Tram / train. Follow the signs from the railway station to the tram. Tram departures are 9.00, 9.15, 9.30 and 10.00. Nottingham High School is the 5th stop and takes around 9 minutes.
