NOTES FOR COMPETITORS

- **Ages:** Juniors are under 18 on 1st September 2019. Seniors are aged 60 or over on 1st January 2019
- **Arbiters' decision:** The Arbiters' decision will be final on all matters regarding the tournament.
- **Byes:** Half point byes may be requested from and are at the discretion of the Arbiter for rounds 1-4. Byes are not permitted for round 5. Only one half-point bye will be permitted for each player.
- **Defaults:** Players not arriving within 20 minutes of the clocks being started for each round will be defaulted. Their opponents will be re-paired if possible.
- **Donations:** All donations towards the cost of staging the championship are welcomed.
- **Grading:** All games will be ECF graded. July 2019 grades will be used. Ungraded players must provide full information regarding their playing ability and any grading previously held. Failure to do so may render a player ineligible for a prize.
- **Mobile phones etc:** All mobile phones and other electronic communication devices must be turned off in the tournament hall. This applies to players and spectators. If a players' phone rings during play two minutes will be added to their opponents clock on the first offence, for a second offence the player will lose the game.
- **Prizes:** In the event of a tie, prizes will be shared. No player may win more than one prize. The County Champion is guaranteed a prize of £50.
- **Refreshments:** Tea, coffee and biscuits will be available free of charge throughout the tournament.
- **Score sheets:** The official scoresheets provided must be used to record all games.
- **Smoking:** Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the school site.
- **Trophies:** The winner of each event will hold the trophy for 12 months or until the championship is next held. Ties will be broken by the following successively: Sum of progressive scores: Sum of opponents progressive scores: Sum of opponents scores: If any changes to the tie break criteria are necessary they will be announced during the tournament.
- **Withdrawals:** Players withdrawing without adequate reason or without notifying the organisers may be refused entry to the next championship. Players who withdraw will not be eligible for any prize.
