Logo Competition, Win A Clock!

Entries are invited for a logo competition, to help provide the NCA with a modern image. Fuller details follow.

Following a request for certificates for some juniors and others, EC has agreed to support a competition to design a new logo for the NCA. For information, for that immediate use, a revamped version of the logo we used many years ago was produced, and is shown here:



For further information, the County Championship trophy bears the motto *defensio optima est aggressio* (meaning *the best defence is attack*); it is entirely up to competitors whether or not to include this motto, or to continue the themes of the former logo, or to invent a new theme that somehow associates Nottinghamshire with chess.

Rules:

- 1. The competition is open to everyone. Entries to be submitted to the NCA President, by e-mail to anw@cuboid.me.uk, no later than the end of July. There is no entry fee.
- 2. Competitors may submit as many entries as they like, in any standard image format.
- 3. Entries will be judged by a panel consisting of S. J. Burke, S. Scott, Dr J. T. Swain and Dr A. N. Walker.
- 4. The winning entry will win a prize consisting of an electronic chess clock. The judges reserve the right to make multiple awards or, if no entry is of sufficient standard, to make no award.
- 5. Entries should be suitable for use in a range of sizes, *e.g.* for letterheads, prize certificates, web pages, and cover pages for publicity material. Some uses may need reduction to grey scale.
- 6. Entrants must agree that copyright in the winning entry will be assigned to the NCA in return for the prize.
