
# TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

Leave the M1 at J26. Follow the A610 for about 4 miles towards Nottingham and turn left at the traffic lights into Forest Road West. The landmarks to look out for on the A610 are going over a railway bridge after about 3 miles, traffic lights at the junction with Gregory Boulevard (A6130) 0.3m, Clarence Pub 0.2m, traffic lights and the Alma pub 0.1m. The Forest Road West traffic lights are a further 0.2m and are immediately preceded by



pedestrian lights. The "Dixy Chicken" is on the corner. Follow Forest Road West for 0.3m, go straight over the Traffic Lights into Forest Road East, and then turn right in about 0.1m into the school car park.

Train / Tram - Follow the signs from the station platform to the trams. Tram departures are at 9.00, 9.15, 9.30, 9.45 and 10.00. The High School is the 5th stop and the journey takes 9 minutes.
